Dear Mr. Killingsworth:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 41 to your NRC Material License No. 21-03039-01 in accordance with your request.

Please note that since your last amendment there have been formatting, verbiage changes, and additions to the standard License Conditions as follows:

- **License Condition No. 13.D. has been revised to include the International System units of bequerels and our standard licensing policy verbiage.**
- **License Condition No. 13.F. was added to specify that leak test records must be maintained for three years and kept in units of microcuries.**
- **License Condition No. 19 was revised to highlight the regulatory requirements for maintaining a minimum of two independent physical controls in the security of your portable gauges.**
- **License Condition Nos. 18 and 23 were updated to reflect current documents incorporated into your license.**

Please also be reminded of the provisions in 10 CFR 30.9(a), "Completeness and accuracy of information," which require that...(a) Information provided to the Commission by an applicant for a license or by a licensee or information required by statute or by the Commission's regulations, orders, or license conditions to be maintained by the applicant or the licensee shall be complete and accurate in all material respects."

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9892 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures

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that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability. You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
