Gentlemen:

We received your letter of August 20, 1981 and check for \$150 (from Cintichem, Inc.), for an administrative amendment to License SNM-639.

Your request has been classified by the Licensing staff as a safety and environmental amendment because the new storage area will require review of safety issues. Therefore, a safety and environmental amendment fee of \$1,400 is required, as specified in fee Category 1D of Section 170.31 of Part 170, copy enclosed. Payment of the additional \$1,250 should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and mailed to my attention. When submitting the fee, please refer to CONTROL NUMBER 19577.

Please note Footnotes 1(d) and 4 of Section 170.31, which provide that upon completion of the licensing review, the Commission will review its expenditures for professional manpower and appropriate support services; recompute the amendment fee, and, if necessary, make any refund.
