Capabilities in Terms of Baseline Needs Assessment -- The SRSFD capabilities discussed and analyzed in the SRS Baseline Needs Assessment include the following: fire suppression, emergency medical, hazardous material, technical rescue response, emergency pre-planning activities, drills, training, work control, and procedures development.
