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

Dear Mr. Jackson:

The enclosed revised Fundamental Nuclear Materials Control Plan is being submitted in accordance with 10 CFR Part 70.32c. The Plan has been rewritten in its entirety in order to have it put onto our word processing system.

This revision incorporates changes reflecting organizational changes, the implementation of U-235 recovery in the waste form process and the expanded storage of the isotope separation process waste drums. SNM accountability has not been affected adversely as a result of these changes.

I have also enclosed a copy of the latest revised Measurement Quality Assurance Manual which now contains the detailed procedures for formulating and certifying standards, calibrating measurement systems and conducting in-process measurements.
