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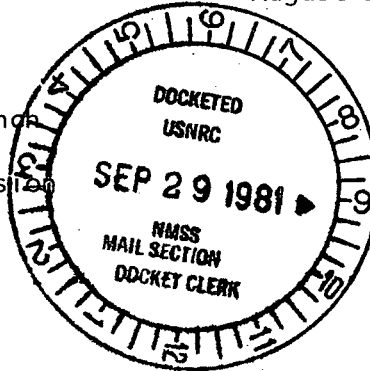

The parameters of the shipment are:

1. One shipment of 24 MTR type fuel elements.

3. Shipping cask will be the Battelle BMI-1 fuel shipping cask
4. Routing to be the same approved route as our November, 1980 shipments.

Gentlemen:

This refers to your August 28, 1981 letter for approval to ship spent fuel to the Savannah River Reprocessing Plant.

The review of licensee route approval requests is subject to the Commission's license fee schedule in 10 CFR 170. For materials licenses, fees for the review of route approval requests are assessed under Category 13 of Section 170.31, as special projects. In accordance with Footnote 8 of Section 170.31, the charge is based on the professional manpower required to conduct the review. In determining the fee, only actual staff time expended in the review of the route request is used to calculate the fee; the route (field) survey conducted by the NRC staff is excluded from fee computation.

When the review has been completed, we will notify you of the fee due. If you have any questions, please contact us.
