PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting is to enable discussion of proposed changes to Supplement 3 of NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1 regarding the development of protective action recommendations. This meeting will provide an opportunity for members of the public, including state and local government officials, to discuss the proposed changes with NRC and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) representatives. This proposed revision to the joint NRC and FEMA guidance document NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Supplement 3 incorporates the following elements:

- Increased offsite response organization involvement in development of protective action strategy;
- Consideration of staged evacuation as an initial protective action at General Emergency;
- Increased use of shelter-in-place for certain scenarios; and

- Guidance to improve communications with the public before and during an emergency.
