SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Bestgen:

In the NRC Form 314 dated February 4, 2010, and facsimile dated May 11, 2010, you indicated that you wished to release the location at "Highway 6, ¼ mile east of St. Joseph, Missouri city limits" for unrestricted use.

You also indicated that all activities authorized by license number 24-25989-01 have ceased and that radioactive materials possessed under this license have been transferred to CPN International - Instrotek.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former location of use and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required for this location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

Therefore, your NRC license number 24-25989-01 is hereby terminated.
