Dear Mr. Dolan:

By letter dated September 24, 2009, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) submitted a supplement to Revision 1 of the environmental report (ER) for the William States Lee III Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2 combined license (COL) application. The supplement to the ER describes the environmental impacts of constructing and operating Pond C, a third cooling water reservoir. This letter presents the requests for additional information (RAIs) for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) review of the supplement to the ER regarding Pond C. The RAIs are presented in tabular format in Enclosure 1.

The NRC requests that Duke provide responses to the RAIs within 30 calendar days of this letter. If changes are needed to the Pond C supplemental ER, the staff requests that the RAI responses include the proposed wording change. For any RAI that cannot be answered in this timeframe, it is expected that a date for the receipt of this response will be provided to the NRC within the 30-day period.
