The paper copy we received doesn't really vary from the information we got in December, except that it has a map of the activities that will affect the oyster bar (Enclosure 6).

I would be interested in seeing the stream and two small ponds downstream from Conoy Pond. They are shown in Figure SE-5 and represent areas WE_3 and WE-4. Also, Woodland Branch would be of interest. I am not sure that any particular section matters. I am pretty okay with going wherever Woody wants to go, however. I don't know how accessible the streams down from Conoy Pond are.

I am curious about the status of this. I sent some questions to Laura and Kathy and wonder what is happening with them, if anything. I think Kathy said she would include them in the Corps review of the plan. Is that still to come? Maybe I should bring some to ask Woody. Also, UniStar still lists stream preservation in its "credit" calculation even though the state says it rarely grants credit for stream preservation. Maybe things are yet to be done before this gets approved.
