In order to incorporate 10 CFR 20 by reference, we had to rearrange the way our regs are organized. No small task, but we're getting there. Subchapter 6 will be deleted and replaced with the incorporation by ref of 10 CFR 20 (excluding Subpart E, except for the minimization of contamination requirement). Anyway, in this incorporation, I change "licensee" to "licensee and registrant", to include our Xray program registrants in 20.1201, 20.1207, 20.1208, and 20.1301. In 20.1301(a)(1), it refers to "licensed operations". I intend to replace that with "licensed or registered operations".
Is any of this language going to interfere with your registered folks?
