In discussions today, I was reminded that New Jersey will need to have Orders/License conditions for the Increased Controls (ICs) and fingerprinting requirements. Although NRC may have these incorporated in the NRC licenses when they are transferred to New Jersey the language would refer to NRC for reporting requirements reference the NRC Orders which may not be legal after the Agreement goes into effect and any new licenses would have to include the requirements. Therefore, we would need to review the New Jersey equivalent of the NRC IC and Fingerprinting Orders/license conditions prior to recommending approval of the proposed New Jersey Agreement in order to make the finding of a compatible program in this area.

I wanted to get this to you so that it would not be a show stopper when you submit the final package.
