We would like to clear up as many of the issues as possible so that we do not need to have another round of questions after we receive the final package.

You are correct on when and where the clock starts. The schedule is a very tight one and only one in the last 5 or so agreement approvals actually met the schedule. We would like to have the New Jersey package be the exception so if you have any questions, please let me know. A little advance notice that the final package is coming in would be quite useful so that we can clear the reviewers' schedules to get right on the review. Our understanding is that the package could be sent to us in late September 2008. Is this correct?
