New Jersey has formally applied to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to become an Agreement State. The NRC estimates that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Bureau of Environmental Radiation (BER) will assume regulatory authority for byproduct, source and small quantities of special nuclear materials effective September 30, 2009. The BER is holding the first outreach session so licensees can learn more about this transition and meet the State licensing and inspection staff.

## **Directions to the Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness Auditorium**

### **FROM THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE:**

Take Exit 7A, and proceed west on I-195.

Take Exit 5A (RT 130 south) to the Horizon Blvd. exit on the right @ first traffic light. Turn right on Horizon Blvd. and proceed to stop sign. The Technology Center will be in front of you.

Make a left turn and the first right turn in front of the complex, which will be on your right on Negron Drive.

For the main entrance (center of the building) make a right again into the visitor parking area.

For Auditorium parking, once you have made the right turn onto Negron Drive, proceed straight to the north side of the Center, passing the Center and making a right between the Center and the NJSP Communications Center, entering the Auditorium parking area.

### **FROM THE PARKWAY:**

Take the Parkway to Exit 98 and proceed west on I-195.

Take Exit 5A (RT 130 south) to the Horizon Blvd. exit on the right @ first traffic light. Turn right on Horizon Blvd. and proceed to stop sign. The Technology Center will be in front of you.

Make a left turn and the first right turn in front of the complex, which will be on your right on Negron Drive.

For the main entrance (center of the building) make a right again into the visitor parking area.

For Auditorium parking, once you have made the right turn onto Negron Drive, proceed straight to the north side of the Center, passing the Center and making a right between the Center and the NJSP Communications Center, entering the Auditorium parking area.

### **FROM TRENTON:**

Take Rt. 29 South to I-195 East.

Take Exit 5A (RT 130 south) to the Horizon Blvd. exit on the right @ first traffic light. Turn right on Horizon Blvd. and proceed to stop sign. The Technology Center will be in front of you.

Make a left turn and the first right turn in front of the complex, which will be on your right on Negron Drive.

For the main entrance (center of the building) make a right again into the visitor parking area.

### **FROM ROUTE 1:**

Take Rt. 1 to I-295 South.

Take I-195 East (Shore Points)

Take Exit 5A (RT 130 south) to the Horizon Blvd. exit on the right @ traffic light. Turn right on Horizon Blvd. and proceed to stop sign. The Technology Center will be in front of you.

Make a left turn at the stop sign and then the first right turn in front of the complex (Negron Drive). The main entrance is in the center of the building.

Take Exit 5A (RT 130 south) to the Horizon Blvd. exit on the right @ first traffic light. Turn right on Horizon Blvd. and proceed to stop sign. The Technology Center will be in front of you.

Make a left turn and the first right turn in front of the complex, which will be on your right on Negron Drive.

For the main entrance (center of the building) make a right again into the visitor parking area.

For Auditorium parking, once you have made the right turn onto Negron Drive, proceed straight to the north side of the Center, passing the Center and making a right between the Center and the NJSP Communications Center, entering the Auditorium parking area.

On October 16, 2008, Governor Corzine signed New Jersey's Agreement State certification letter to the NRC. The certification letter is a formal request to establish an Agreement between the NRC and the State of New Jersey, as authorized under Section 274b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (as amended), and under Section 9.1 of the New Jersey Radiation Protection Act (N.J.S.A. 26:2D). The formal New Jersey application was submitted to the NRC on October 20, 2008. The application consists of six volumes addressing the NRC's required elements for becoming an Agreement State. The elements include legal, regulatory requirements, technical staffing and training, licensing and inspection programs, enforcement, and event and allegation response. These volumes can be found on the US NRC's website under the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System. The ML accession numbers are given below.
