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Across the site we have been focused on design, construction, the NRC Operational Readiness Review and final activities to begin initial plant operations. Consistent with the timing of my assuming responsibility as President and Chief Executive Officer of URENCO USA, I am pleased to announce the following changes in Executive Management effective May 3, 2010:

- ❖ Dave Sexton will assume responsibility as Chief Nuclear Officer and Vice President Operations. Organizations previously reporting to Jerome Reed and functional responsibilities for Chief Nuclear Officer are being assigned to this position.
- ❖ Jerome Reed will assume responsibility as Vice President Project. This includes responsibility for continued site expansion and the Project organization previously announced that includes Project Phase I, Phase II, Construction, Engineering, Scheduling, and other project support and turnover functions.
