This refers to your license amendment request. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license. Please note that the license conditions were updated in accordance with current NRC policy. In addition, the statement formerly listed in Condition 10, related to the FAA jurisdiction over radioactive materials in commercial launch activities, has been removed. Based on our review of licensing documents, this statement was added in 1997 when the license was amended to add the nickel-63 sources; these sources are no longer authorized on this license as a result of this amendment.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
