Dear FOIA officer,

Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request a copy of Docket No. 50-413, and 50-414. In addition, I would like a copy of the NEPA analysis used to evaluate this license amendment, along with any reports or evaluations related to the actual irradiation of MOX fuel in the Catawba reactor.

President Obama has instructed the heads of executive departments and agencies to renew their commitment to Open Government to emphasize the importance of transparency in a democracy.

"The Freedom of Information Act should be administered with a clear presumption: In the face of doubt, openness prevails. The Government should not keep information confidential merely because public officials might be embarrassed by disclosure, because errors and failures might be revealed, or because of speculative or abstract fears. Nondisclosure should never be based on an effort to protect the personal interests of Government officials at the expense of those they are supposed to serve. In responding to requests under the FOIA, executive branch agencies (agencies) should act promptly and in a spirit of cooperation, recognizing that such agencies are servants of the public."

I understand that this information should be provided within 20 business days of this request.
