The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the response to request for additional information (RAI) 177. RAI 177 addresses the Fire Protection Program, as discussed in Section 9.5.1 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

The referenced letter anticipated that the response would be provided by June 1, 2010. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI 177, Question 09.05.01-14. The response will be provided to the NRC by June 25, 2010.

There are no regulatory commitments identified in this letter. This letter does not contain any proprietary or sensitive information.
