On Friday, April 16, 2010, we received government-to-government notice from the nuclear materials regulator in Canada consenting to one shipment of cobalt-60 not to exceed 244.2 TBq to MDS Nordion, located in Canada. This consent expires on April 16, 2011.

When the NRC issued the amended license PCB6.10, it was issued with the condition that Alpha Omega Services, Inc. was prohibited from shipping 10 CFR §110 Appendix P Category 1 quantities of cobalt-60 to Canada until: (1) Alpha Omega Services, Inc. requested the NRC to obtain specific consent from the importing country's regulatory authority, on a case-by-case basis; (2) NRC has considered government-to-government consent pursuant to 10 CFR § 110.42(e)(3); and (3) NRC informs Alpha Omega Services, Inc., in writing, that it is authorized to ship the materials to the recipient(s) specified. Therefore, the conditions necessary to ship to MDS Nordion have been met and you are authorized to make shipment as authorized in PCB6.10 to this location in Canada.
