Hi Mark

I just wanted to give you an update on the soil disposal request. I spoke with your consultant (Mr. Henry Morton) today, and the NRC is requesting that a dose assessment also be submitted, since this will be the basis for any future NRC approval. Once we receive this document, I will forward to our Health Physicist for review in a timely manner as the NRC is aware of the time constraints for USACE to move forward on cleanup activities at the site.

In previous conversations with Mr. Morton, he indicated that the RCRA Subtitle C Facility was not identified in the April 14, 2010 letter [ML101200105] because Stepan wants the option to dispose of this material at a local RCRA C Facility. Please note that if NRC approves the disposal of unimportant quantities of material, Stepan must obtain the necessary approvals and permits from the State and local government prior to the disposal of the material at the selected facility.
