SUBJECT: INFORMATION AND GREEN TECHNOLOGY VENDOR FAIR

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) Chief Information Officer (CIO), and in support of agency emerging business and technology requirements, the Office of Information Services (OIS), the Computer Security Office (CSO), and the Office of Administration (ADM) are jointly hosting an NRC-wide Information and Green Technology Vendor Fair. The theme for this year's vendor fair is entitled, "*Opening the Door to the NRC's Information and Green Technology Portfolio.*"

The fair will be held in the auditorium on Tuesday, July 20, 2010, from 12:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. There will be a vendor check-in period at 12:30 p.m. Starting at 1:00 p.m., the CIO will deliver the welcome speech, followed by brief remarks from the Office Directors of OIS, CSO and ADM. The remaining time will be set aside for one-on-one conversations between NRC staff and vendors.

Discussions will be limited to fifteen minutes per vendor, per table. We will devote up to two tables to each of the below-listed areas, depending on the amount of participation from the offices. Topics include:

COTS and Application Development (i.e., off-the-shelf solutions, as well as, software tools, and programming)

Organizational Productivity (i.e., network communication and collaboration tools and virtual meeting -video and audio capability)

Web 2.0 (i.e., secure social networking approaches, content management, web technologies and portals)

Business Continuity (i.e., Contingency of Operations Plan (COOP), Disaster Recovery, and Incident Response)

Enterprise Security (i.e., encryption, network access controls, security monitoring)

Cloud Computing (i.e., moving services, computation and/or data off-site to an internal or external location, which is a transparent, centralized facility or contractor)
