Below is a summary of the inconsistencies in the Chapter 2 FSAR that we discussed this morning. If you have any questions, please let me know.

### Snowpack

- Table 2.0-201 states the 100-year return period ground-level snowpack of 12.2 lb/ft<sup>2</sup>
- FSAR Section 2.3.1.3.4 (page 2.3-14) states the 100-year return period snowfall is equivalent to 12.4 lb/ft<sup>2</sup>

### X/Q

- Table 2.3-221 state the site limit X/Q values at the LPZ Boundary for 8-24 hours and 1-4 days as 7.45E-04 and 2.84E-04, respectively
- Table 2.0-201 and FSAR Section 2.3.4.2.1.1 (page 2.3-60) state that the site limit X/Q values at the LPZ Boundary for 8-24 hours and 1-4 days as 7.45E-05 and 2.84E-05, respectively
