Public Meeting with Licensee for Calvert Cliffs

On May 24, 2010, the staff held a public phone conference with the licensee for Calvert Cliffs to discuss the licensee's planned responses to an NRC staff request for additional information regarding Generic Letter 2004-02, "Pressurized Water Reactor Sump Performance."

Fire Protection Meeting on National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 805 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

On May 27, 2010, the staff held a Category 2 public meeting with the Nuclear Energy Institute NFPA 805 Task Force, other stakeholders, and the public, to discuss the FAQs related to the licensees' adoption of NFPA 805. The staff began holding these monthly public meetings in July 2006 and expects to continue holding them at least throughout the transition period for the pilot plants adopting NFPA 805.

Staff Attendance at Sandia Workshop on Used Fuel Disposition

On May 18-19, 2010, staff from NMSS and the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses attended a workshop at Sandia National Laboratory on the Sandia Used Fuel Disposition Campaign, to help inform the development of the NRC's Plan for Integrating Spent Nuclear Fuel Regulatory Activities. Other attendees included staff from the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response and Office of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards at NRC, as well as staff from other national laboratories, the U.S. Department of Energy, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Nuclear Energy Institute, and the Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board. Topics discussed in the workshop, including potential future repositories, interim storage, transportation, and alternative fuel cycles, will be covered in a report to be developed by Sandia this fiscal year.

Publication of Draft Regulatory Guide 1248 (DG-1248) "Nuclear Power Plant Simulation Facilities for Use in Operator Training, License Examinations, and Applicant Experience Requirements."

On May 27, 2010, the RES staff issued DG-1248 to provide an opportunity for public comments. The draft guide is proposed Revision 4 to Regulatory Guide 1.149 that describes methods acceptable to the staff of the NRC for complying with those portions of the Commission's regulations associated with approval or acceptance of a nuclear power plant simulation facility for use in operator and senior operator training, license examination operating tests, and meeting applicant experience requirements.
