Subject: Docket No. 50-482: Resubmittal of Enclosure Submitted with License Amendment Request for Deviation from Fire Protection Program Requirements

Gentlemen:

Reference 1 provided Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation's (WCNOG) License Amendment Request (LAR) to make changes to the approved fire protection program as described in the Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR). Specifically, a deviation from certain technical requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix R, Section III.G.2, as documented in Appendix 9.5E of the WCGS USAR, was requested regarding the use of operator manual actions (OMAs) in lieu of meeting circuit separation protection criteria.

NOTE: Enclosure I to this letter contains sensitive information and should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390. When Enclosure I is separated, this letter including Enclosure II is "Decontrolled."

SECURITY-RELATED INFORMATION – WITHHOLD UNDER 2.390

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Reference 2 provided a Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) request for additional information (RAI) related to the LAR in Reference 1. Reference 3 provided WCNO's response to that NRC RAI.

Included as Enclosure I of Reference 1 was WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revision 0, "Post-Fire Safe Shutdown Operator Manual Actions." In WCNO's response to the NRC RAI (Reference 3), WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revision 1, was provided as an enclosure, which replaced Revision 0 in its entirety.

After additional consideration it was determined that the enclosures to References 1 and 3, WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revisions 0 and 1 respectively, contain sensitive information concerning WCGS's physical protection, and should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1).

Enclosure I of this submittal is WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revision 1. Enclosure I contains sensitive information, which is enclosed in brackets, and should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1). Enclosure I of this submittal does not change any information previously submitted in the enclosure to Reference 3, however, the addition of the brackets altered the spacing and lines in some areas, causing it to differ slightly in appearance.

Enclosure II of this submittal is the redacted version of WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revision 1, which has the sensitive information inside the brackets removed and can be released for public disclosure. The information removed and brackets added also altered the spacing and lines of this version in some areas, causing it to differ slightly from the enclosure to Reference 3 and the version containing the sensitive information.

Enclosures I and II of this submittal replace WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revisions 0 and 1, contained in References 1 and 3 in their entirety. Therefore, the enclosures (WIP-E-1F9900-004-A-1, Revisions 0 and 1) to References 1 and 3 should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1).

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.91, a copy of this submittal is being provided to the designated Kansas State official.


