Plant.

I urge you to reject this  
license renewal until + unless the  
recommendations of the California  
Energy Commission are met for  
"advanced 3-D seismic reflection  
mapping + analysis of a newly-discovered  
earthquake fault near the Diablo  
Canyon plant."


This plant was flawed from  
the start due to poor design +  
PGE's deceptive tactics in lying  
to the PUC to get the initial  
licensing in 1982. Diablo Canyon  
is literally on shaky ground, +  
California rate payers have
