Subject: Request for Additional Information for the Limited Authorization Request, Model No. BMI-1 Package

Mr. Curley,

I am reviewing your request for limited use of the Model No. BMI-1 transportation package. Please be aware, when staff issues an authorization for limited use of an expired package, it must specifically identify the number of shipments and will also have an expiration date. In conjunction with our review of your application, I need the additional information as described below.

Please confirm your exact number of expected shipments and the date by which you would complete the shipments.

Please consider, if NRC issues an authorization, you must still request and receive Department of Transportation authorization via registered user status to the special permit that allows use of expired NRC certified packaging. I anticipate that the earliest that NRC could issue a licensing decision is the week of June 7th, and that DOT will require some period of time to process your request (please confirm the time needed with Mr. James Williams at DOT, 202-366-6177).

Please provide this information by Monday, June 7, 2010.
