This record represents a series of telephone and e-mail communications with Dr. Bose on 5/18, 5/27, 6/7, and 6/8/10.

- 1) Table 3.c. of the submitted form 313A (RSO) indicated the facilities providing training required by 10 CFR 35.50(e), but did not identify the supervising individuals or license numbers. I asked Dr. Bose to identify the supervising individual for at least one of the facilities listed in each category authorized (or currently proposed to be authorized) on HUH's license.

Dr. Bose responded that Andy Bukovitz supervised the training provided at UPMC Latrobe Area Hospital in 2002-2003 and Rick Piccolo supervised the training provided at University of Virginia in 1997-2000.

[An ADAMS search confirmed that Mr. Bukovitz was RSO and AMP for HDR in Latrobe Area Hospital's NRC license number 37-09463-01 during the stated time period. An ADAMS search also confirmed that Rick Piccolo was RSO for University of Virginia's medical broadscope license number 45-00034-26 during the stated time period.]

- 2) Table 3.c. of the submitted form 313A (RSO) did not show any training and experience in 35.300 uses after 2000. I asked Dr. Bose to provide documentation of continuing training and experience in topics related to 35.300 uses within the past 7 years.

On 6/8, Dr. Bose said that he will obtain additional training from a 35.300 AU and provide documentation. I asked for this to be submitted within 30 days.
