To treat the environment and all living things, including my pets, with respect and care.

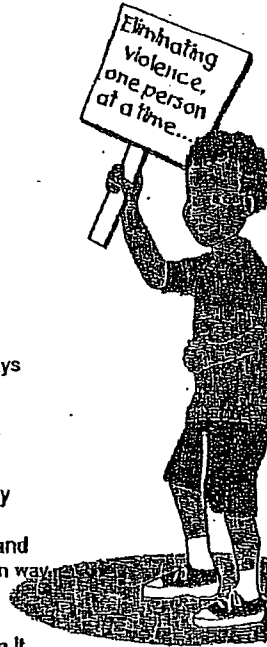
### To Play Creatively

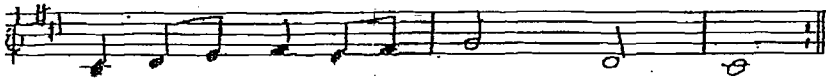
