In the renewal application submitted May 27, 2010 MedStar informed the NRC that the RSO (Dennis Clum) had resigned his position effective the end of May. In addition, they informed us that Auroba Al-Samaraee would be the temporary RSO, a position she held previously in 2009. MedStar has a contract with Ms. Al-Samaraee for a period of 60 days at which time she will be returning to Dubai. During Ms. Al-Samaraee's tenure, MedStar will conduct a national search for a replacement RSO. Synergy has been retained to conduct the search. If an acceptable RSO is not found in 60 days, MedStar plans to submit Guiseppie Esposito, M.D., Director of Nuclear Medicine, as a candidate for the RSO position. Dr. Esposito will be attending a Medical RSO training course in July. MedStar understands that a physician is not the perfect candidate for the RSO position due to their limited availability and will continue to search for a full-time RSO. Ultimately, MedStar would like to hire a RSO, Deputy RSO, and a Health Physicist.

On June 8, 2010, Emma Hooks, Assistant VP, and I discussed MedStar's immediate and long-term plan for the replacement of the RSO. On June 10, 2010 I requested that MedStar put the plan into writing and submit it to the NRC. Ms. Hooks stated that she had put together a plan and submitted it to her supervisor the other day and that she would forward the plan to me.
