The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is publishing a direct final rule, in the *Federal Register*, that will amend the list of approved spent fuel storage casks. NRC is approving the revision of the NAC International, Inc., NAC-MPC System for storage of spent fuel under the new conditions specified in the revised Certificate of Compliance. This amendment will include changes to the configuration of the NAC-MPC storage system. Also, the amendment will incorporate minor editorial corrections and include newly defined terms.

The amended NAC-MPC System, when used in accordance with the conditions specified in the certificate and NRC regulations, will adequately protect public health and safety and the environment. This cask system will continue to allow holders of power-reactor operating licenses to store spent fuel in the cask system under a general license.
