Hi Amy,

We talked last week about the NJ Agreement and the Congressional letters once we have an SRM on the paper. I am trying to get all the pieces lined up for Dennis Sollenberger, who will be working on this while I'm on AL 5/6-12/09, in case we get an SRM before I get back to the office.

Because of our fast turn around time once we get an SRM, which will impact the overall schedule, I wondered if you would take a quick look at the letter and make sure you don't need any changes, corrections, additional addressees - anything I can do before I go will help expedite the process. The ML is ML090820386. I've attached a copy of the letters from ADAMs.

Once we have the SRM, we will be coordinating closely with ADM for the publication of the FRN, but know that we need to give you all time to get the Congressional letters out. Our goal is to have the FRN noticed no later than 5/20/09, if we get the SRM early enough. This means we'd need the FRN to ADM by the afternoon of 5/14/09 - they will get it to the Office of Federal Register on 5/15/09 and it would be noticed on 5/20/09. I understand from our conversation that you would need to have the Congressional letters out so that they have them by 5/18 or 5/19.

All of this is to time the effective date of the Agreement for no later than 9/30/09.

I'll be in the office on Tuesday, 5/5/09. After that, Dennis will be the contact until I return - his phone number is 415-2819.
