What we're saying here is that the Commission implements 274c of the Act by 10 CFR 150.15(a)(6) and the only thing limited right now is exempt distribution - if you're going to distribute products to end users exempt from requirements, you have to have a license from the Commission.

So, it's kind of a summary from the Act, down through the regulation. The "it" is referring to the Section of the Act, via the regulation.

Would it help to say, "The Commission implements this Section of the Act by regulation in 10 CFR 150.15(a)(6), with the only limitation being the distribuion of products to persons exempt from regulatory requirements." ??
