I had a question for you Donna - and I'm off to a 2:00 meeting - for a couple of hours.

We're working for the briefing to Charlie and then Marty on the SECY paper

Marty wants the briefing because "in the past NJ has dabbled in thing outside their purview and he wants to make sure those things have been resolved. He mentioned that we had a similar situation with Minnesota."

Here's what I found out so far - from Dennis, Rosetta, and such: Under 274i agreement, NJ was going a bit far into role with reactors - wanting to do independent evaluations, look at engineering designs; but Dennis didn't think they were trying to apply regulatory requirements on the reactors. He understood Minn was trying to pass regulations that applied to reactors where they had no authority.

The other issue we have is Shieldalloy - we know there is a lawsuit re; on-site disposal issue - as a stakeholder and not trying to assert authority. Of course, we can't talk about the details of the lawsuit.

Do you have any more info/background that Marty may be getting at or that we should be prepared to answer? Rosetta thought Nancy McNamara might have some information.

Of course, I wouldn't hesitate to get back to the TA and ask, but I wanted to check here first and cover the bases.
