FSME/DMSSA/ASPB staff is requesting OGC analysis on comment four of SRM-SECY-08-0154-Proposed Agreement between the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Commission Pursuant to Section 274 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, As Amended (ML083100927).

The comment reads as follows : "As part of the Commission paper for the New Jersey Agreement, the Staff should include its evaluation and recommendations for resolution of the apparent differences of the standard agreement between a State and the NRC providing for discontinuance of the NRC's regulatory program in relation to Section 274 c. of the Atomic Energy Act and 10.CFR 150.15(a)(6)."

FSME/DMSSA/ASPB Staff is asking OGC for a response to the following:

- 1) Should the standard agreement be changed to reflect Comment 4 of SRM-SECY-08-0154?
- 2) If it is decided upon that the standard agreement should be changed based on the Commission's comment, where should the change be made?
- 3) If a change is made to the standard agreement would it be necessary to change all other standing State agreements?

We would like to meet with you to discuss this matter further. We also have had substantive conversations with two Commission offices on this subject and we would like to share this information.

In order to incorporate your input prior to the final Virginia and draft New Jersey Agreements (both scheduled to be sent to the Commission in January), please provide your analysis by no later than January 9, 2009.
