I'm updating the "Byproduct Materials" fact sheet, last revised in October 2006. It states, "In Fiscal Year 2005, the NRC completed nearly 3,300 reviews of materials licensing actions, including new applications, amendments to existing licenses, license renewals, and sealed source and device reviews. The NRC conducted 1,264 inspections of materials licensees in the same year. The corresponding radiation control programs in the Agreement States have approximately 80% of the materials licensees, so the actual number of licensing actions and inspections performed within the United States is actually much greater."

Do we have such figures for FY08? Or a running total for FY09 that I could use if I wait another couple weeks to finalize this?
