Dear Mr. Ransohoff:

This is in reference to your application dated May 18, 2010 and additional information letter dated June 3, 2010 applying for a Nuclear Regulatory Commission license. From a preliminary review of your request we have determined that additional information is needed as follows:

You have requested to refurbish teletherapy units for re-sale. This activity would normally be considered as a new distribution and require that details be provided in the application as is normally included with applications for sealed source and device evaluation and registration (NUREG-1556 Vol.3, Rev.1) and NUREG-1556 Vol. 12. You may refer to previously submitted documents, however, you would need to address each area of the guidance documents to include new labeling and the quality assurance program.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material; then Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
