In its Initial Scheduling Order dated May 19, 2010, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") identified time frames within which evidentiary hearings will be held, e.g., for safety issues, the evidentiary hearing will likely be held between the months of December 2010 and February 2011 (inclusive), and for environmental issues, the evidentiary hearing will likely be held between the months of June and August 2011 (inclusive). Initial Scheduling Order at 8. The Board further indicated that, unless necessary, it would not conduct hearings during the time period from December 20, 2010 to January 3, 2011, inclusive. Initial Scheduling Order at 8, fn 13. The Board directed the parties to submit a "calendar identifying the dates during the above-referenced time frames when they (and their witnesses) are NOT available for an evidentiary hearing in the Idaho Falls, Idaho area." Initial Scheduling Order at 8.

In accordance with the Board's direction, Attachment A reflects the availability for counsel and Staff witnesses for each of the evidentiary hearings.


