The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the submittal of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 guidance and strategies for Loss of Large Areas (LOLA). The LOLA guidance and strategies are required for compliance with 10 CFR 50.54(hh)(2) and 10 CFR 52.80(d). UniStar Nuclear Energy (UNE) is developing the guidance and strategies utilizing the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) template document NEI 06-12 and NRC Interim Staff Guidance (ISG) ISG-016. UNE previously provided a schedule for submitting this information in the above referenced letter.

UNE had anticipated that the information described above would be provided by June 30, 2010. UNE requires additional time to finalize the LOLA guidance and strategies as a supplement to the CCNPP Unit 3 Combined License Application. The information will be submitted to the NRC by January 30, 2011.

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There are no regulatory commitments identified in this letter. This letter does not contain any safeguards, proprietary or sensitive information.
