PURPOSE: To discuss proposed changes to Supplement 3 of NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1 regarding the development of protective action recommendations. This proposed revision to the guidance document NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Supplement 3 incorporates the following elements:

- Increased use of shelter-in-place for certain scenarios; and
- Guidance to improve communications with the public before and during an emergency.
