We have reviewed the Nevada license condition that was submitted to address RATS 1993-1 Decommissioning Recordkeeping and License Termination requirements received by our office on August 5, 2009. This license condition was reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC rules in 10 CFR 30, 40 and 70 and the requirements of the one amendment identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the license condition with Sneha Ravikumar on August 27, 2009.

As a result of our review, we have no comments. We have determined that Nevada's license condition meets the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.
