Me again - in retrospect, I should not have used the word "docketed" in referring to these petitions. Technically, the petitions have been **filed** (the Caliente Hot Springs Resort petition was in question as to whether the **filing** would be accepted because not all of the procedures appeared to be followed, but that was worked out and it is now filed). The 50-day window for replies starts with the date of filing (on the 14 petitions, the dates range from 12/19 to 12/22).

While not "docketed," the filings can still be viewed in the electronic hearing section of the Web site.
