The purpose of this letter is to provide a schedule update for the response to request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated April 30, 2010 (Reference). This RAI addresses Severe Accident Evaluations, as discussed in Section 19.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

Reference 2 stated that following the AREVA response to U.S. EPR RAI 133, Question 19-243, UniStar Nuclear Energy would provide an updated response to RAI 241, Question 19-25. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by July 30, 2010.
