Dear Mr. Wiberg:

This refers to the telephone conversation between you and me on June 7, 2010, regarding the letter dated March 9, 2010, signed by your Radiation Safety Officer, David Rands. Mr. Rands requested termination of your NRC license number 48-23476-01 in this letter but did not provide complete supporting information for processing.

As discussed during our phone conversation, you were not aware that the request to terminate your NRC license had been made. Since we did not have complete information to process the termination and you expressed the intention to not terminate the license, it was agreed that we would void the pending termination request at this time.

This will allow you and your staff to determine what, if any, action is to be taken with your NRC byproduct materials license. This action is taken without prejudice to future resubmission of a license amendment request.

If you and your staff wish to pursue the termination of your NRC materials byproduct license, please submit the additional information requested below (Enclosure 1), in writing, addressed to my attention and refer to it as "additional information to control number 318895." We will then continue our review.

Termination Information Requested

Termination Information Requested

1. All documentation sent to the NRC should include a legible signature, the title of the person providing the documentation (should be a senior management official), and the date. These measures help us to better secure your license.
2. NRC Form 314 "Certification of the Disposition of Material" is available to capture the minimum required information for terminating an NRC byproduct materials license. Below is a link for this form and the instructions on how to complete it:

Additional items to complete the termination request should be appended to the NRC Form 314.

3. Please provide the most current copies of both Agreement State radioactive materials licenses referenced in the letter dated March 9, 2010, i.e., issued by the States of Minnesota and Wisconsin, in which the materials currently authorized by the NRC license are being transferred.
4. Please submit signed and dated acknowledgments of receipt for the materials transferred to the States of Minnesota and Wisconsin materials licenses. 10 CFR 30.41 and 30.51 require this information. The acknowledgments of receipt should include, but not necessarily be limited to, the identity of the radionuclides transferred, the chemical/physical form (such as sealed sources), the activity at time of transfer, manufacturers' names and model numbers, serial numbers, dates accepted into recipient licensee's inventory and an appropriate senior management official's signature.
5. Please provide copies of the most recent leak tests conducted on the materials transferred to the other license(s) to demonstrate that none of the sources were leaking at the time of transfer.
