On April 27-28, 2010, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a special inspection at the Trojan Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate whether the protection of the ISFSI was in compliance with Physical Security Plan (PSP) for the ISFSI, and the additional security measures imposed by the NRC Order dated September 17, 2007. At the conclusion of the on-site inspection on April 28, 2010, the inspectors discussed the inspection findings with members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified.
