Thirty-five hard copies of each presentation or handout should be provided to the DFO thirty minutes before the meeting. Presenters should also provide the DFO with a CD containing each presentation at least 30 minutes before the meeting. Electronic recordings will be permitted. Detailed procedures for the conduct of and participation in ACRS meetings were published in the *Federal Register* on October 14, 2009, (74 FR 58268-58269).
