Dear Mr. Thompson,

I am writing in response to your letter of June 14, 2010 and our telephone conversation of earlier today. As a practical matter, it seems as though the principal point of concern regarding the issuance of the new license concerns the re-manufacturing and distribution of teletherapy units.

Our understanding is that consideration of this activity for the new license will delay the issuance for an extended period of time. Although this activity is an important part of our business, we do not want to delay the issuance of the new license, so we hereby request that the new license be issued without authorization for teletherapy unit re-manufacture at this time. If required to do so, we will plan to amend the new license to add that activity at a later date.

We maintain that the new license should be an Manufacture and Distribution license as we do sell sources from inventory from time to time. However, if consideration of this activity would also add significant delay to the issuance of the new license, then we hereby request that the new license be issued without that activity as well.

In closing, we request that the new license, whether you determine it should be a Manufacture and Distribution, or Service Provider license, authorizes us to perform all activities associated with;

- the installation, relocation, maintenance, inspection, repair, and removal of


