Enclosed is Amendment No. 06 to your NRC Material License No. 24-32042-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that the final reviewer for this amendment has changed from Jose Macatangay, who you spoke with on the telephone on May 26, 2010, to me, Colleen Carol Casey. If you have questions or concerns about your license, amendment or this letter, please contact me at (630) 829-9841.

In the course of this review I noted that the name of your company, as indicated on your letterhead and on the Form NRC 313 dated March 30, 2010, is "Koehler Engineering & Land Surveying, Inc." The corporate name on your license is "Koehler Engineering & Land Survey," which is different.

Please advise us immediately if your company has experienced a name change, which will require an amendment to the license, or a change in ownership and/or control, which must be consented to in writing by the Commission after you have submitted a request for NRC's evaluation.

Please refer to 10 CFR 30.34(b), NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, section 8.2, Item 2, and Appendix C for assistance in this matter.

I also noted that the cover sheet to the facsimile dated April 1, 2010, sent by J. Beussink, asked whether a fee was associated with this amendment. Fees questions are best answered by calling Brenda Brown at (301) 415-6055.

However, in general, we do not require amendment fees payments unless the amendment is adding a new type of use to the license that, absent an existing license, would have resulted in a new license application. For the most part, we only charge new license fees and annual fees, but again, Ms. Brown can provide you with more current information.


Please also note that License Condition No. 20 has been added to your license to reflect the requirements for particular conditions of use for the portable gauge.

Failure to conduct your program in accordance with In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
