1. Reference "Nuclear News" magazine (Amer Nuclear Society) Oct 2008, pg 80
U.S. DOE spent \$10 Billion and 20 years to submit an 8600 page application for Yucca Mtn nuclear waste repository.
The U.S. taxpayers deserve a thorough and timely USNRC review of the application. What are we doing to future generations if Yucca Mountain is cancelled on political grounds?
2. If U.S. Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid (D-NeV), a vocal opponent, has comments he should file his written position for appropriate USNRC consideration. (cf e.g. 6.4 below)
3. I endorse US DOE Secretary Samuel Bodman position "As energy demand in the United States grows, the expansion of commercial nuclear power will be the key to providing the large amounts of emissions free baseload power we need, and the establishment of the Yucca Mountain repository is an important step toward enabling that expansion to occur."
4. "We need nuclear power." (An Oak Ridge citizen)

5. My 16 page campaign summary, enclosed, provides further perspective and elaboration. Note especially page D re: 999 Billion barrels EW (Earthworld) Oil Reserves and 360 A-BWR units.

6. Specific Additional Comments

6.1 If USDOE has spent \$10 Billion on Yucca Mountain, it should/should already have spent \$10 Milion each for two alternate sites to permit a comparative analysis, and basis for site selection.

6.2 The USDOE/USNRC docket should consider Yucca Mountain capacity (in 1 GWe x 40 years units) without nuclear fuel reprocessing (President J. Carter executive order), and with nuclear fuel reprocessing (changed Government policy by new USAPres Executive Order, e.g. ifbe USAPres D.M. Axelerod, or by Congress law, such as the Energy and CLimate Change legislation).

We need nuclear power, and 1/6 A-BWR nuclears + 1/6 Other Nuclears assumes nuclear fuel reprocessing and Yucca Mountain waste repository. Waste volume to be stored with nuclear fuel reprocessing is estimated to be less than 10% of waste without fuel reprocessing.

6.3 Reference "Nuclear News" Oct 2008, page 82 and 85. Savannah River, So Car poured 10 million pounds of glassified (vitrified) waste, and is considering improvements with Russian CCIM vitrified waste technology.

What improvements in long term safety are possible with CCIM vitrified waste vs reprocessed waste in highly corrosion resistant metal or vs. retained in as-used fuel assemblies?

To what extent should USDOE/USNRC recommend waste preparation for storage at Yucca Mountain (or other repositories).

6.4 Vitrified, processed waste suggest the possibility of repositories within 3 hour drive of nuclear fuel reprocessing plants. To what extent does this address USSen Reid's CONUS (continentaul US) transportation concerns, and provide additional capacity beyond Yucca Mountain?

Local has plan to deal with country's debt

 Pres. Bush 43 ran up over \$5 trillion in debt in 8 years. Pres. Obama's FY 2011 budget is a national tragedy and is expected to add another \$5 trillion debt in only four years. All of this debt has led Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke to say the cumulative debt is "unsustainable" and a "risk to the USA."

What might be done about \$10 trillion debt in 12 years?

A. Accept the deficit (Cheney's curse: "Deficits don't matter.")

B. VAT. Value Added Tax, an abhorrent regressive tax.

C. Declare USA government bankrupt.

D. Monetize the debt at \$1 trillion per year times 10 years, and accept limited inflation as a result.

E. Begin rollback of the deficit by \$500 billion (\$ 1/2 trillion) for FY 2011, to be legislated in 2010, as summarized in the attached tables.

The tables summarize what I consider to be a responsible alternate budget compared with the Obama national tragedy budget, and highlight key revenue taxes and key outlay spending differences. Adjust revenue in diverse ways, and cut spending where spending is greatest.

My idea is to raise Fossil Fuel taxes, which would have a dual benefit. It would both be anti global green-

house gasses, and fund energy conservation and energy production to replace oil that is running out.

I propose:
 • 2010 - Add a 50 cents per gallon tax on auto fuel, which would generate an additional \$75 Billion per year.

• 2011 - Tax natural gas and coal for \$50 billion per year.

• 2012 - Add a 50 cents per gallon tax on auto fuel, which would generate an additional \$75 Billion per year. (For more information about these ideas send \$2.00 to me at 121 Nesper Road, Oak Ridge, TN 37830-5356 for my budget details and ten page campaign summary.)

Looking beyond FY 2011, how do we reconcile a medical spending shortfall of \$500 billion per year? Specifically, \$700 billion spend (\$450 B + \$250 B) compared with Medicare Tax \$200 billion. (See chart again.)

My political judgment budget guidelines are:

• \$500 B FEDMED(ical) at per capita 13.2 percent to states and 86.8 percent to countries.

• \$500 B DOD (base).

• \$100 B FEDED(ucation).

• \$100 B FEDEN(ergy).

Note: \$B = \$ Billion per year.

Appoint Ross Perot Director OMB, and appoint up to 50 key GS-18 Senior Civil Servants under him to rebalance the budget by FY 2013.

Have Congress debate and pass a proto-typical FY 2011 Budget LAW this year, along the lines I've proposed. (Please remember that a "bill" is in Congress, while a "law" is signed by the U.S. President.) Have the Congressional Department Authorization Committees in 13 weeks pass the Dept Authorization bills in accordance with the FY 2011 Budget Law. Eliminate the Congressional Appropriations Committees and staffers - A duplicating, costly

insult to the US Constitution Article 1, Section 9.7

The U.S. President signs the Dept Authorization bills into Appropriation Laws.

Pass a Balanced Budget Amendment to the U.S. Constitution along the lines I've proposed, to make explicit the implicit Constitutional contract between the USA government and the people to balance the budget.

Allowing \$10 trillion debt in 12 years must never happen again.





STATEMENT ON ENERGY and GLOBAL WARMING

4July 2009; 27Dec2009

1a. I condemn the word "hoax" in the headline:

"The man-made global warming hoax" (Oak Ridge Observer, 2July09)

1b. I hold: Manmade global warming is real and needs to be limited.

1c. CO₂: 1958 315ppm. 2007: 385 ppm. IPCC: CO₂ biggest factor

NOAA: 1960 +0°C. 2007 +0.6°C. (TJBasling, OR Natl Lab, 9Dec 09)

1d. Oak Ridge National Laboratory, "ORNL Review" 42-2, pg5 (2009):

"On the climate front, most studies estimate that the world will need to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions 50 to 80 percent--a significant range--by 2050 in order to stabilize atmospheric CO₂ at levels that will avoid dangerous climate change."

2. I take note of U.S. House of Representatives passed (219-212) Energy bill, specifying reduction in global greenhouse gasses of:
-17% by 2020 (Knoxville News Sentinel, Assoc Press, 27 June 2009.)
-80% by 2050 Pres Obama G8 Summit 8July: -80% 2050

I question how to achieve -80% by 2050. -80% by 2050 is Radical.

2c. I support -50% by 2050. Visionary, conceivable, difficult to achieve Basis low of 1d. ORNL position and WURO Runout (World Ultimate (conventional) Recoverable Oil, largely gone by 2050.

3. I advocate:

→ A. New nuclear fission electric power @ 100GWe/decade= 400 GWe by 2050
=400 plants @ 1 GWe = 32q, quadrillion BTU/year

→ B. New WEG: Wind Electric Generators 100GWe/decade= 400 GWe 2050





300 GWe NUCLEAR POWER IN 30 YEARS

As we approach the anniversary of 9/11/01 destructive action, it is appropriate to discuss Constructive Action, 300 GWe Nuclear Power in 30 years. The weavers (Builders) of history must prove greater than the slashers (destroyers) of history.

Nuclear Fission Electricity frees Coal for Oil

It is envisioned in 30 years, say 2015 to 2045, that coal electricity go from 300 to 100 GWe, as coal plants, largely built in the 1960's end life. A gigawatt electric, GWe, is a billion watt electric. The Bull Run coal fired steam electric plant, in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, is about 1 GWe. It uses 100 railroad cars at 100 tons coal/ car, 10,000 tons of coal per day, nominal. This can, at 20+ Million btu/ ton of coal, make 20,000 barrels of oil at 6 Million btu per barrel. A typical oil refinery is 200,000+ barrels/ day. The coal to oil is 65% efficient, coal to electric is 35-40% efficient.

It is envisioned that nuclear power go from 100 GWe to 300 GWe in 30 years (and indeed, possibly every 30 years for the rest of the century, to USCanMex 1000 GWe by 2100). The current 100GWe of nuclear power, built largely in the late 1960's/ early 1970's will also, despite 40 to 60 year life extension licenses from US Nuclear Regulatory Commission, face end of useful life. The life extension needs to be proven.

216 GWe of A-BWR on USDOD bases

The primary nuclear plant construction effort in the next 30 years would use existing technology: 0.6GWe, passive safety-natural circulation A-BWR Advanced Boiling Water Reactors made by General Electric. 360 would be ordered by the USA Government, for 90 USDOD Division CONUS (Continental USA) Bases, at 4each/ CB, total $90 \times 4 \times 0.6 = 216$ GWe.

The A-BWR Division in the Engineering Service would do the site preparation, including the big hole for the reactor building, and the administration building, and road and rail access, and construction support installations - - e.g. concrete batch plant; laydown areas; warehouses, etc. and security roads and fencing. The A-BWR Division would then morph into the A-BWR operating division, at 200 men per 2 GWe (Nominal) = 20,000. US Army Engineer Corps would develop the site preparation capability and the US Navy nuclear program the nuclear operations capability. The US Department of Energy would contract for the plant engineering, licensing, manufacturing, and construction, perhaps at \$20 Billion/ year.

Additional Nuclear Capacity LWR by Electric Utilities

Electric utilities have already started up the preliminary effort on over two dozen nuclear fission LWR (Light Water Reactor) PWR/ BWR (Pressurized Water Reactors and Boiling Water reactors) some to 1.5 GWe. Several different reactor manufacturers have been selected by the electric utility executives.

My preference would be for 1 GWe WS-HWBR, World Standard Heavy Water Breeder Reactor, with nuclear fuel reprocessing to recover the plutonium produced (more new fuel than consumed in breeders). One division, 2nd USAEC (US Army Engineer Corps) Division, at Fort Leonard Wood, MO would oversee the prototypical 2x1 GWe World Standard HWBR. The other 9 USDOD Division Conus Bases (CB), are in earthquake prone California, and would have energy storage capability, rather than nuclear power plants. At \$1 + Billion per 0.6GWe ABWR, the total would be over \$200 Billion. Allowing two years for licensing and site preparation in parallel, and four years to build the first of 4 units, and one unit every 1 to 2 years after that, would take 10-15 years to bring the 216 GWe A-BWR on line, or by the 2020+ timeframe.

Perspective: Such capacity would help to assure a reliable supply of electricity for 40 to 60 years after that, particularly to meet the projected needs of plug-in electric automobiles, such as the Chevrolet Volt, 40 mile/ electric charge, scheduled to be offered in 2010. It is likely to become a mainstay of the USA auto fleet by 2020 since most people drive less than 40 miles/day. A hybrid gasoline-electric car, e.g. a Toyota Prius might be a family 2nd car, or a rent-a-car, for long trips such as family vacations. As T. Boone Pickens notes in his advertising, with imported oil costing \$700 billion per year, more than USDOD budget, this 216GWe A-BWR major mission of USDOD would be a vital role for achieving World War III (World Peace 1) LTES (Long Term Energy Survival).




