Critical Digital Assets must be protected by security controls as required by 10CFR 73.54(c)(1). The Calvert Cliffs Unit 3 Cyber Security plan, footnote 1 on page 10 states:

"[Sufficient is defined as in all controls implemented where applicable by Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Project, LL via Appendix A and Appendix B of 51-7002224 (Latest Revision)]"

Please explain the meaning of this footnote.

Critical digital assets must be protected by security controls as required by 10 CFR 73.54 (c)(1). The phrase "as applicable" is used throughout the Calvert Cliffs 3 cyber security plan in the context of security control implementation. Please describe who determines applicability and what criteria are used to determine applicability.

Critical digital assets must be protected by security controls as required by 10 CFR 73.54 (c)(1). On page 19, in Section 2.2.1.2 of the Calvert Cliffs 3 cyber security plan it states: "Audit generation is only being applied to certain CDAs and CS; not the entire group comprising the architecture." How is the subset being determined and what is the justification for limiting audit generation to only this subset?
