**Enclosed is Amendment No. 35, which terminates your NRC Material License No. 39-24888-01, in accordance with your letter dated March 10, 2010, requesting that we change your company's mailing address from 8550 Dorchester Road, North Charleston, South Carolina to the new address in Rancho Dominguez, California.**

**Since the mailing address change involved different states, it was necessary to terminate your existing license concurrent with the issuance of a new license reflecting the California address. Your new license no. 04-24888-01 is enclosed also and its expiration date is the same as on your previous license, February 28, 2014.**

**At this time we also updated Condition Nos. 23 and 24, and we added the docket number for your previous license to the docket number for the new license in Subitem No. 5, as shown in bold font.**


documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
