| Also on the call was Stephen Lemont of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the project leader for the NRC's AREVA Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility EIS. On the call for the BLM was Wendy Reynolds, Bill Boggs, and Becky Lazdauskas. The purpose of the call was to determine the BLM's opinion on how construction and operation of the EREF in the Idaho desert would effect surrounding land uses. Wendy Reynolds is a land use specialist with the Bureau of Land Management Snake River Field Office. She indicated that the BLM does not expect that the construction and operation of the EREF would have any effect on the surrounding land uses. Current activities including grazing, recreation and hunting are expected to continue on the public lands surrounding the EREF. | |
